

7/21/2021 COVID-19 Update (data is as of 7/20/21).

**Summary:**

- **Cripple Creek:** Cripple Creek has added only 1 new case so far in July. The total local case count is 136.
- **Teller County:** Teller County has added 24 new cases so far in July. Recent new case count by month: June 91, May 179, April 232 and March 150. CDPHE's COVID-19 total case count for Teller County as of yesterday is 1,945.
- Teller County is reporting that, as of this week, 49.15% of the eligible population is full vaccinated.

**Overall Teller County Status:**

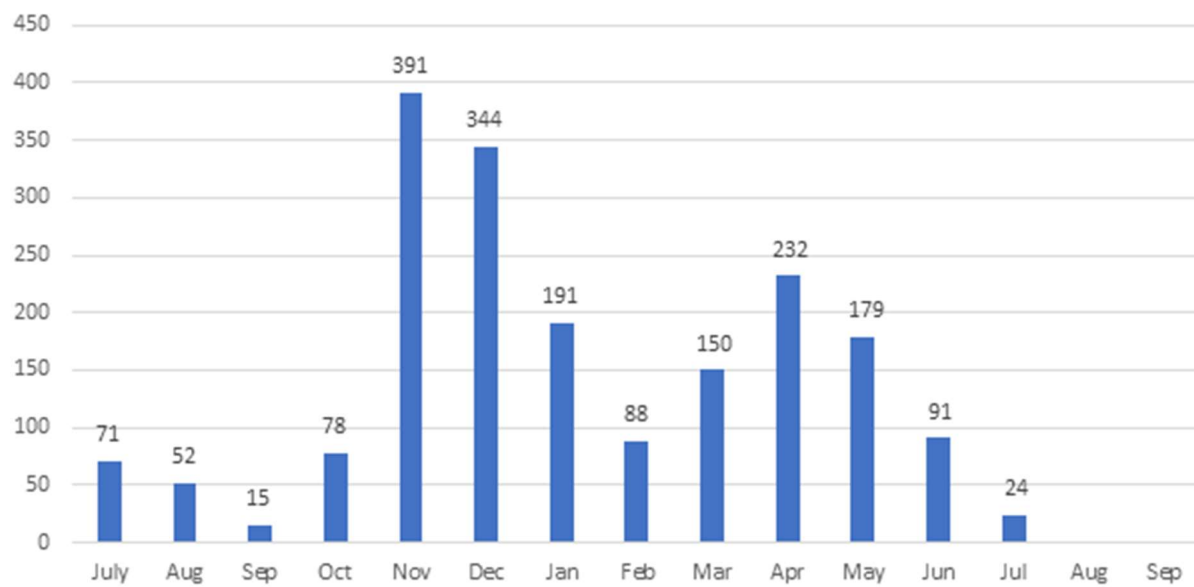
- **One Week Cumulative Incident Rate:** Current figure is 43.4, which is worse than last week's figure of 31.6.
- **Two Week Cumulative Incident Rate:** Current figure is 78.9 which is worse than last week's figure of 51.3. Anything over 300 is considered condition RED.
- **One Week Positivity Rate:** Current figure is 2.8%, which is worse than last week's figure of 2.5%. The goal is under 5%.
- **Hospitalization Rate:** Teller County is currently reporting in the 1 – 2+ range of new hospitalizations in the last two weeks.

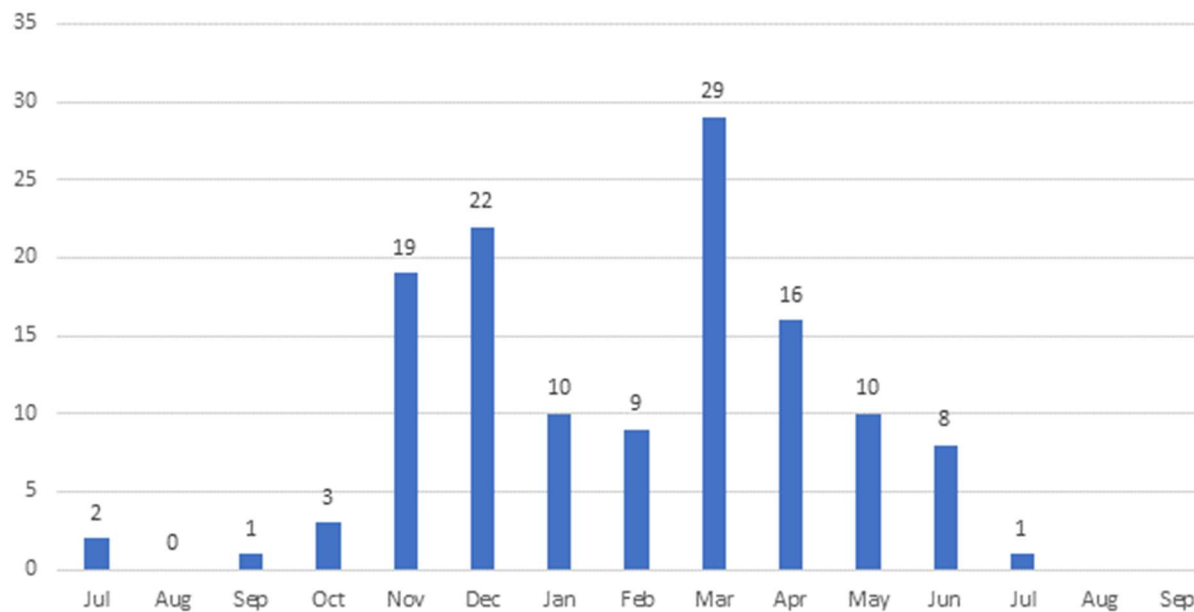

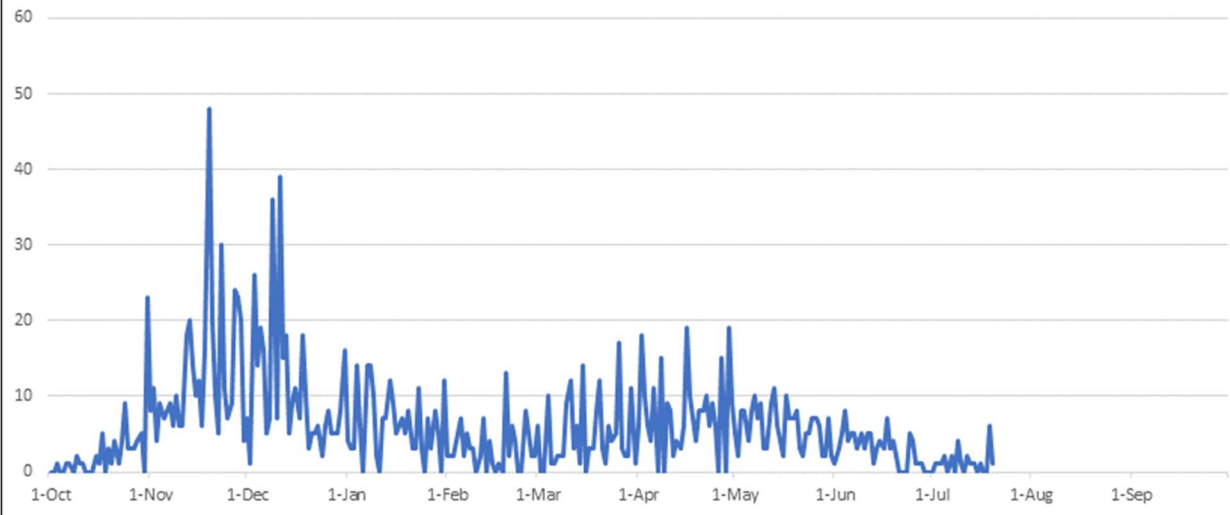
### New COVID-19 Cases in Teller County by Month
