

6/22/2022 COVID-19 Update (data is as of 6/21/22).

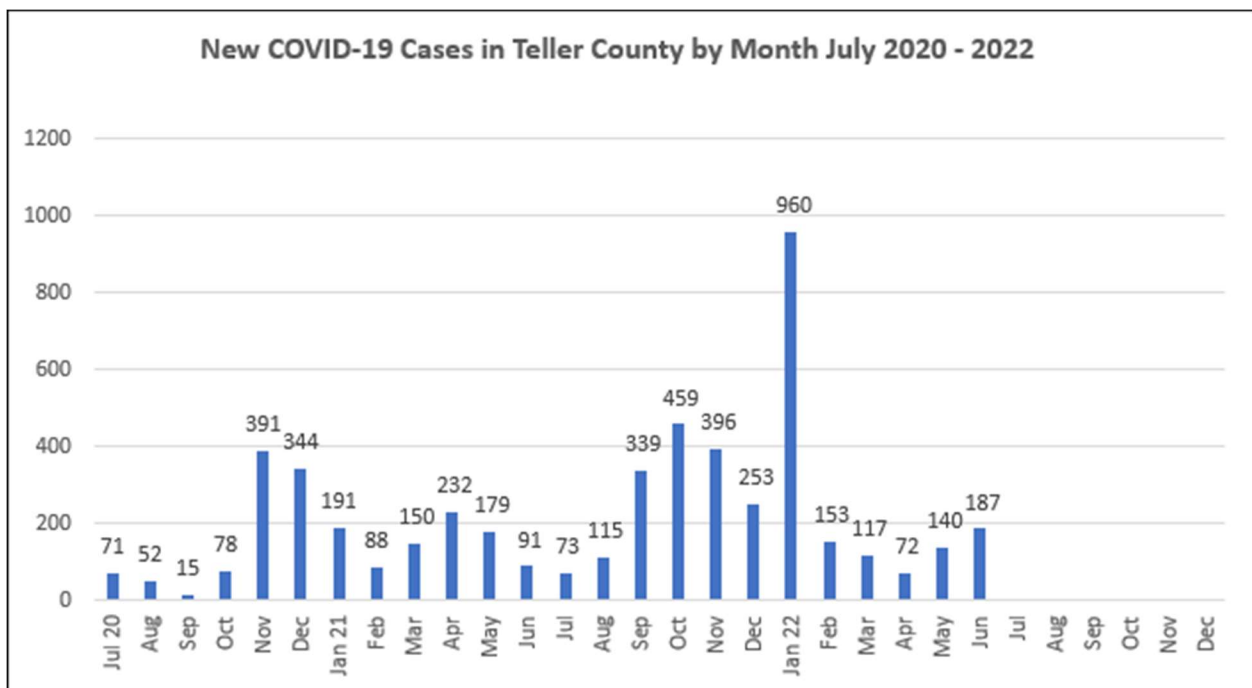
Summary:

Cases continue to increase. 187 new cases have been added in Teller County so far in June. All three of the main metrics are worse this week, compared to 6/8's report. Fortunately, no deaths have occurred in June. CDPHE's COVID-19 total case count for Teller County as of yesterday was 5,185, up 147 cases from 6/8's figure of 5,038.

Important Metrics:

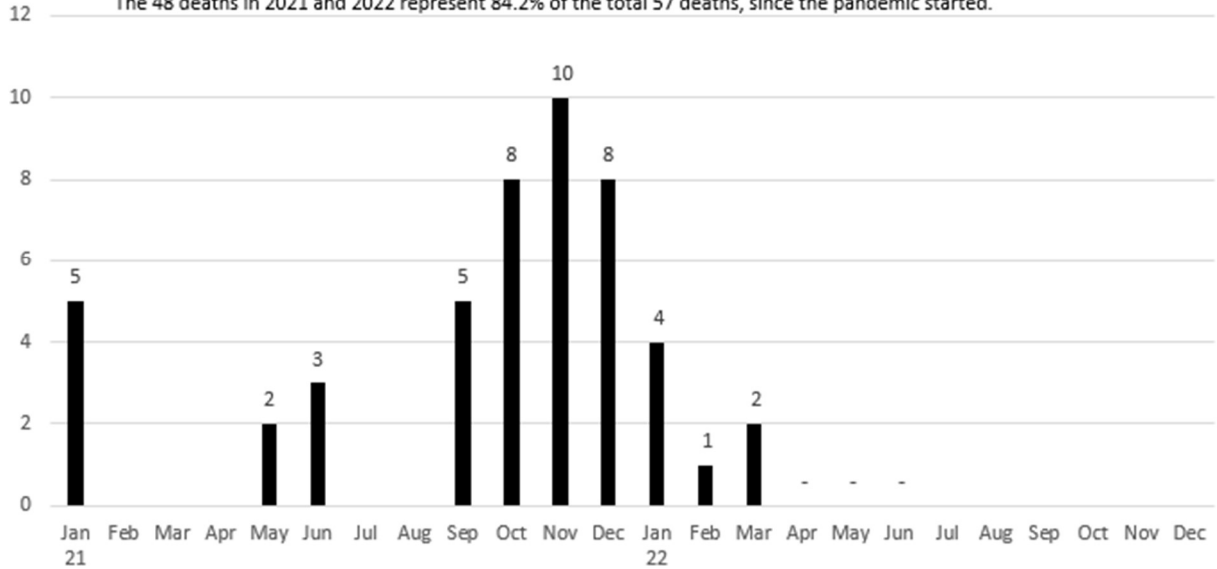
- **One Week Cumulative Incident Rate:** Status: YELLOW. Was YELLOW 6/8. Current figure is 282.5, which is worse than 6/8's figure of 161.4.
- **Two Week Cumulative Incident Rate:** Status: RED. Was ORANGE 6/8. Current figure is 500.5, which is worse than 6/8's figure of 266.4. Under 25 is Green, Blue is 25 - < 75, YELLOW is > 75 – 175, ORANGE (High Risk) is >175 - 300, and RED is over 300 on the State Dial.
- **One Week Positivity Rate:** Status: RED. Was RED 6/8. Current figure is 17.7%, which is worse than 6/8's figure of 11.7%. The goal is under 5%.

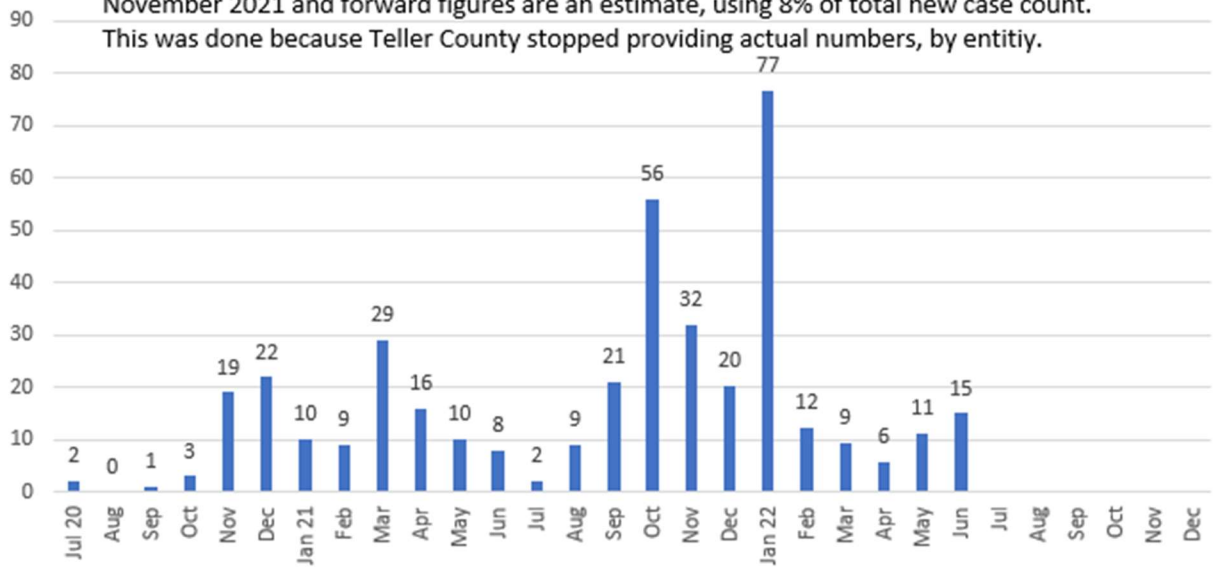
Teller County COVID-19 Deaths by Month 2021 and 2022

The 48 deaths in 2021 and 2022 represent 84.2% of the total 57 deaths, since the pandemic started.

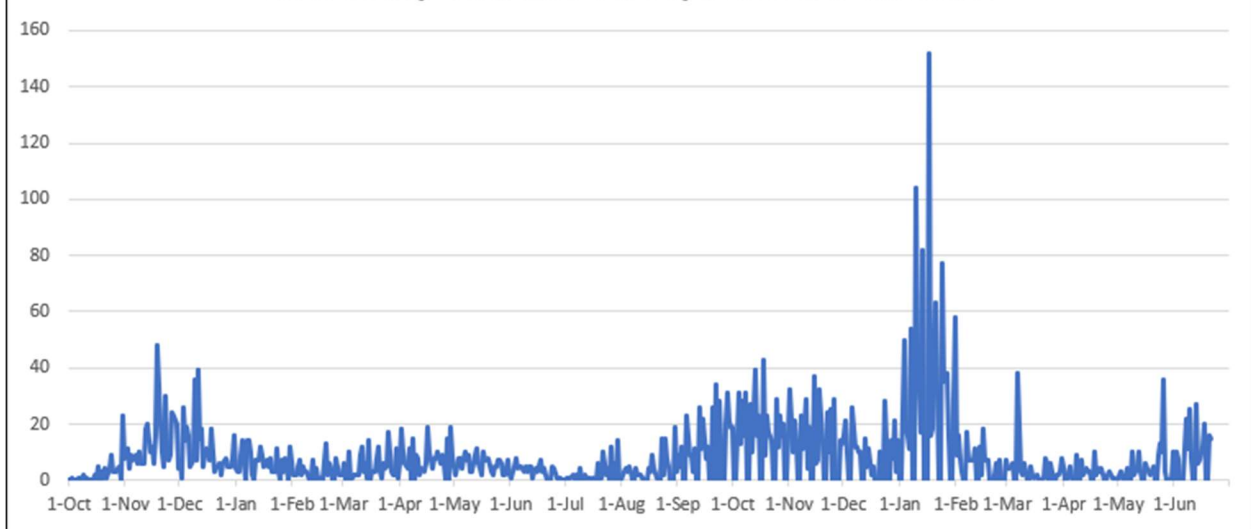


Cripple Creek - New COVID-19 Cases, By Month
