Dear Citizen:

With the winter season upon us, we would like to remind all property owners and occupants in the city of their obligation under the Cripple Creek Municipal Code to remove ice and snow from the sidewalks adjoining their property. Section 11-1-10 of the Municipal Code states as follows:

Sec. 11-1-10. Snow and ice removal from sidewalks.

The owner, occupant, lessee or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property, and shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed or cleared away, snow and ice from sidewalks in all business districts within the City by four (4) business hours after the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain or by the beginning hours of the next business day following such fall, whichever period is shorter, and from all other sidewalks in the City within twenty-four (24) hours of the cessation of any fall of snow, sleet or freezing rain.

We request that a less corrosive product be used on the sidewalks such as Safe Pet or Pet Friendly. However, regardless of the product utilized, we ask that it be used sparingly and to cleanup excess product to prevent slip and falls.

We recognize that this requirement is not always convenient but your compliance with this ordinance makes for a better and safer community.

We wish you warmth and comfort this winter.
