11/17/2022 COVID-19 Update (data is as of 11/16/22).

Summary:

Beginning in November, CDPHE is updating new case counts, etc. once a week vs. daily. In the first sixteen days of November 23 new cases have been added, for a daily average of 1.43, which is an increase over last week's figure of 1.25. One of the three main metrics are better this week, compared to last week's report. CDPHE's COVID-19 total case count for Teller County as of yesterday was 5,745, up 13 cases from last week's figure of 5,732.

Important Metrics:

- One Week Cumulative Incident Rate: Status: BLUE. Was BLUE 11/9. Current figure is 48.4, which is worse than last week's figure of 40.4.
- **Two Week Cumulative Incident Rate**: Status: YELLOW. Was YELLOW 11/9. Current figure is 109, which is worse than last week's figure of 104.9. Under 25 is Green, Blue is 25 < 75, YELLOW is > 75 175, ORANGE (High Risk) is >175 300, and RED is over 300 on the State Dial.
- One Week Positivity Rate: <u>Status: RED. Was RED 11/9</u>. Current figure is 13.5%, which is <u>better</u> than as last week's figure of 14.3%. The goal is under 5%.
