A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESTRICTIONS ON OPEN BURNING IN THE CITY OF CRIPPLE CREEK, COLORADO.

WHEREAS conditions throughout the region have improved leaving the City of Cripple Creek in a less vulnerable condition for wildfires.

WHEREAS the City Council adopted a Stage 2 Fire Ban on open burning on April 5, 2023.

WHEREAS current conditions and circumstances within the City of Cripple Creek no longer necessitate the imposition of fire ban restrictions on open burning to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

WHEREAS the City of Cripple Creek Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that adoption of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation and protection of the public health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Cripple Creek.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Cripple Creek, Colorado as follows:

The Stage 2 Fire Ban enacted by Resolution on April 5, 2023, is hereby rescinded.

Open burning on private and public lands in Cripple Creek, State of Colorado, shall revert to those limitations established by Cripple Creek City Ordinance and the laws of the State of Colorado.

The burning of Rubbish is **PROHIBITED** in Cripple Creek at any time. Rubbish includes paper, garbage, trash, useless waste, rejected or waste foods, offal, and tires.


While conditions have improved, the potential for devastating wildfire to impact the health, safety and welfare of the community can never be eliminated. All inhabitants are strongly encouraged to exercise caution with any flammable or combustible material near open flames.

All Fire Ban restrictions shall be rescinded as of May 3, 2023, at 5:30 PM.
